## World News

While most of the news focuses on the failed Russian coup, the middle-east continues to simmer. For instance, the fighting between Israel and the West back continues [1]. During one attack on Jenin in the northern West Ban, Israel forces killed at least five people [2].

The barracks that will house the Wagner Group fighters in Belarus were on display [3]. The fighters are expected to operate out of this location [4]. However, there are reports the group's leader is in Russia [5]. It is unclear why he would be in Russia but suggests there is more to the story than is currently known. In any case, Poland has moved 1,000 tropes to the east to reinforce against any Wagner Group threat [6].

Meanwhile, smoke from the Canadian fires has reached Europe [7]. By one estimate, the fires could last for months [8]. What's more, other factors impact the weather. Case in point, a large solar storm produced expectations of communications failures [9]. Such storms also produce Aura Borealis events seen further south tan normal [10].

Iran continues to exert its military power. Case in point, a commercial ship was seized in international waters [11]. Iranian officials claimed they had a court order to seize the ship [12].

# Ukraine War

The long expected Ukraine offensive is moving slowly [1]. However, the progress is sluggish and the Russians have mined the areas [2]. Meanwhile, Moscow airport flights were disrupted due to a Ukrainian drone attack on the Russian capital [3].

It appears there was an attempted coup against Putin that ended as quickly as it started [3]. As part of the settlement, the head of the Wagner mercenary

group will move to Belarus [4].

Another consequence of the Ukraine war is that Russian forces are actively challenging the US elsewhere. For instance, Russian SU-35 fighters harassed US operated MQ-9 Reaper drones operating over Syria [5]. In further escalation, the US will provide cluster munitions (banned by over 100 countries) to the Ukraine [6]. Not everyone approves of the weapons, the UK, Canada, New Zealand and Spain are opposed [7].
