# World News

The Russia-Ukraine war just got more complicated. It appears the pro-Russian, breakaway region of Transnistria in Moldova has asked Russia for protection against Moldova [1]. Transnistria is a long sliver of land that separated the Ukraine (in the South) from Moldova [2]. This comes as Russian forces are continuing to secure a number of battlefield victories [3]. The Russians appear to be advancing along the entire front [4]. Additionally, Russia's leader has warned that if pressed, he would authorize the use of nuclear weapons [5]. This would likely include tactical nuclear weapons, such as those maintained in Belarus [6].

The Houthi fighters continue to be active. For example, a cargo ship was stuck with a missile that killed three people [7]. Another report indicates the Houthi rebels have obtained some hypersonic missiles [8].

India continues to improve its military capabilities. For instance, the Indian Navy recaptured the Maltese-flagged bulk cargo vessel Ruen from Somali pirates [9]. India also tested a 5,000 Kilometer range missile capable of carrying multiple warheads [10]. These capabilities should help check China. For instance, China is developing a new generation of mobile ICBMs [11].

While most of the world is focused on Russia, China continues to expand its military capabilities. Case in point, China plans to increase its military budget by 7.2% [12].

## The conflict between Hezbollah and Israel continues to escalate. For example, on February 26, Hezbollah fighters fired 60 rockets into the Golan Heights [1]. The rocket fire prompted responses from the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) along the border [2].

In Lebanon, Hezbollah fighters fired over 100 rockets into Israel [3]. In response, IDF jets hit targets in the Bekaa Valley [4]. As the war continues, IDF forces continue to strike targets within Lebanon [5]. One of the challenges is

getting aid to the people in the Gazza Strip. For example, reports indicate 20 people may have been killed while waiting for aid [6]. To address the issue, President Biden committed to constructing a Gazza pier that will allow ships to unload supplies [7].

President Biden has warned Israel not to strike Rafah where many Palestinian refugees are gathered [8]. Nevertheless, a report indicates that Israel has started such a campaign [9].
