## World News

D rones launched by the Ukraine from withing Russia, struck targets destroying dozens of military aircraft [1]. Satellite images confirm a number of Russian aircraft were destroyed during the attack [2]. In a phone call with President Trump, Putin warned there would be a response to the drone attacks against Russia [3]. In response, Russia launched a large drone and missile attack against targets withing the Ukraine [4]. For instance, on June 7, Russia struck, Kharkiv, with the most powerful attack on that city during the war [5]. As the world moved its focus toward the Iran-Israel war, Russia continued to strike Kyiv and other Ukrainian cities [6]. Finally, North Korea is sending another 6,000 troops to help Russia in its war [7].

In a show of force, two Chinese aircraft carriers conducted exercises in the western Pacific Ocean [8]. Reports indicate Russia is using a Chinese anti-drone laser system in the Ukraine [9].

n June 14, Israel struck Iran's nuclear and military leaders using over 100 drones and 200 fighters [1]. In response, Iran launched 100 drones at Israel [2]. One report suggests the Israeli intelligence agency, the Mossad, previously set up drone sites within Iran that were used to destroy surface to air missile sites [3]. Then, Iran launched ballistic missiles killing at least 3 people [4]. Commercial satellite imagery shows damage to Iranian nuclear and missile sites [5].

## Middle-East War

Then on June 21, the US bombed three Iranian nuclear sites [6]. In response, Iranian officials warned of everlasting consequences [7].

Meanwhile, the conflict between Israel and Syria continued. For instance, Israel stuck targets after two projectile were launched from Syria [8].

On June 5, Israel forces struck Beirut's southern suburbs, targeting a Hezbollah underground drone production [9].

On June 10, the Israeli navy

attacked docks in Yemen's port city of Hodeida [10]. Meanwhile, the Houthis launched ballistic missiles into Israel [11].
